## **Local Rules**

The rules of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the following local rules govern all play:

**1.** Stones in bunkers, "Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)";

Maximum time of play at tee

- **2.** Greenkeepers work is considered ground under repair. Relief without penalty may be taken in accordance with Rule 25;
- 3. In addition to rule 24-2, should a ball come to rest within 3 club lengths short of the wall a player may choose to move the ball to the nearest of the two drop zones and drop under provisions for drop zones without penalty;
- 4. Course conditions (a) embedded balls (b) need to clean ball, lift clean and wipe (c) preferred lies/winter rules (d) aeration holes. Relief will be available at certain times of the year and notice will be given at Reception and on the member's notice board;

- **5.** Out of bounds ( Rule 27 applies) (a) beyond boundary fences (b) beyond white posts outlining out of bounds:
- 6. Immovable obstructions Rule (24-2) Relief may be taken from; (a) water irrigation equipment (all sprinkler heads and control satellites) (b) buggy paths, bridges and service roads (c) stone constructions outside a hazard, including retaining walls and boundary walls (d) young trees which have been tagged or staked.

## Etiquette

- **1.** No player may start a round without registering at Reception.
- **2.** The Marshalls may instruct players to quicken their pace of

- play or allow a group through; any requests ignored may result in the players being asked to leave the course. A 4-ball is expected to play 18 holes in 4h30 (pace of play);
- 3. If any group loses more than one hole on the group in front they must call the following group through. Failure to do so in competitions will incur penalties;
- **4.** Golf shoes with soft spikes must be worn;
- **5.** The Club dress code described in the notice board must be adhered to.

100, 150 and 200 metre distance markers are measured to the front of green.
