


- 2. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)
- a) Beyond boundary fences.
- b) Beyond white posts outlining out of bounds.
- c) In the car park beyond 18th Green.
- 3. Lateral Water Hazards are defined by Red stakes (Rule 26.1c) applies.
- Stones in Bunkers
   Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
- Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24.2)Relief may be obtained from:
- a) Water irrigation equipment (all fixed sprinkler heads and control satellites).

- b) Young trees which have been tagged with blue bands or are staked.
- c) Buggy paths and service roads.
- 6. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25.1)
- a) All areas marked GUR defined by blue stakes.
- b) All drainage depressions.
