

# LOCAL RULES

1. A ball lying on a buggy path, flower bed, tyre marks caused by tractors, machinery etc. "through the green" may be lifted and dropped, without penalty, at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, within one club length.
2. If the wooden fencing along the side of the buggy paths interferes with the players' stance or swing, relief may be taken without penalty, at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, within one club length.
3. All fixed sprinkler heads and control boxes are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if the sprinkler head intervenes with the line of play within two club lengths of the putting green, the ball may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to avoid such intervention.
4. A ball lying within one club length of an unmarked drain on the fairway may be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within two club lengths, no nearer the hole.
5. Stones and fir cones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
6. Out of bounds; white marker posts, on and over all perimeter roads, boundary fences, all villa gardens.
7. Lateral water hazards: Red marker posts. Rule 26 applies.
8. Water hazards: Yellow marker posts. Rule 26 applies.
9. Ground under repair areas; blue marker posts. Rule 25-1 applies.
10. Sandy waste areas on the 5th, 15th & 16th are not hazards. The club may be grounded. Relief must be taken from landscaped areas within these areas, within one club length, no nearer the

hole and remaining within the area. Relief from footmarks may be taken within these areas, no nearer the hole, within one club length.

11. Fairway distance markers are in meters (1.1yd = 1m) and are measured to the front of the greens.
12. Flower beds around dry tree, 14th hole, Rule 25-1 applies.
13. Distances on the card are to the centre of the green.

## Golf Dress Code

Soft spikes only. T-shirts, jeans, trainers and bathing shorts are not permitted on the golf courses. Shirts with collars and golf trousers / tailored shorts must be worn at all times.

## Etiquette

Pace of play - The time allowed to play 9 holes is 2 hrs and 10 minutes or less.

Starters & Rangers - All players must observe their instructions

Please rake bunkers, repair pitch marks and replace divots

Buggies - Keep to buggy paths at all times.
